St Lucia Electricity Services Limited (LUCELEC) wishes to advise its customers of a malicious email that is purporting to be from the company, requesting them to download and view a recent payment receipt.

LUCELEC customers are advised this email is not from St. Lucia Electricity Services Limited and should be immediately deleted. Further, under no circumstance should the mentioned attachment be downloaded or opened.
