**FUEL SURCHARGE COST ADJUSTMENT**

**Applied to Bills for July 2026**

The fuel surcharge cost adjustment is the cost of fuel at the current price less the average cost of fuel in the twelve months preceeding 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2026 (the base price) divided by the total number of kwhs sold.
